THE OFFERTORY

(LSB 421)

Jesus, grant that balm and healing in Your holy wounds I find,
Every hour that I am feeling pains of body, and of mind.
Should some evil thought within tempt my treacherous heart to sin,
Show the peril, and from sinning, keep me from its first beginning.

THE PREPARATION

P: In the midst of our Lenten journey, we come to Jesus for peace and hope, for Him to lead us away from temptation, and for our Savior to speak forgiveness to us from his cross.

P: Christ was wounded for our transgressions. He was bruised for our iniquities.

C: **He was delivered up to death; He was delivered for the sins of all people.**

P: Lord, remember us in your kingdom and teach us to pray:

C: **Our Father who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name, thy kingdom come, thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread; and forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us; and lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. For thine is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever and ever. Amen**
