L: In the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.

C: Amen.

L: He was despised and rejected by men, a man of sorrows and acquainted with grief;
and as one from whom men hide their faces he was despised,

C: And we esteemed him not.

L: Surely he has borne our griefs and carried our sorrows; yet we esteemed him

C: Stricken, smitten by God, and afflicted.

L: But he was pierced for our transgressions; he was crushed for our iniquities; upon
him was the chastisement that brought up peace,

C: And with his wounds we are healed.

L: All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned – every one – to his own way;
